



Orphan Care

I want to highlight an incident from India close to my heart. One morning I had an urgent phone call from a man wanting me to go across town to meet him. I said I couldn't come right then and asked what the matter was.

He said if I was willing to take an infant to adopt, the baby was right in his arms and ready to be given over. The parents did not want another girl child, so they wanted to get rid of her. This person was contacted to pick up the baby and give it up for adoption or take it to a government center. The story ended there with me saying, "I am not able to take the baby," and she was taken away.

There are lot of girl children who are orphans who need care or a helping hand to go to school. Gloryshine is praying and seeking the Lord to provide us with resources to take care of the orphan girls to give them shelter, food and education. We are planning on taking three girls who are either full or semi-orphans this year. They will be coming to our main church by May to begin school in June.

Please meet Anusha, on the left. She is 13 years old. Her father was murdered by his relatives because of a family land dispute. She and her younger sister live with their mom. She has been able to go to the village school but now she needs to go to 7th grade in the nearest town.



Her mom planned to stop sending her to school because it is too risky to go to town every day. Her mom accepted Christ through us before and now has asked if we could help her with education. We said we would and will take her in our main church to stay with the pastor's family and go to school in the town there. We have two other girls who are in the same situation. Chandana on the right lost her father in a train accident and her mother abandoned her.

It will cost us \$60 a month for each of the three girls and we trust that God would provide for them.
