Please Meet R.

R. is an adult. When he was a boy he lived in a hostel and went to school. During his childhood years he used to attend a church with his friends, although he was a Hindu.

At about twenty-five he became sick with rheumatic fever, taking away his ability to walk or work for a living. He sought out many doctors but none could help him. In his desperation he remembered the church he attended as a child and started to pray to Jesus. Miraculously God started to work in his life and he experienced healing.

He met one of our pastors in door to door ministry and wanted to share his testimony, wanting to know more about the Jesus who healed him. For the next year our pastor followed up with him and shared the gospel with him. He came to know Christ and we were able to arrange a Christian marriage for him. They got married last month.



Future plans: If the Lord allows, Joseph will be visiting India December 15 – January 15, 2019. He plans to take a missions team with him for evangelism and training pastors. He is also working on a course for our pastors, a Diploma in Theology.

We are looking for teachers in the States to go with him to participate in the course.

Orphan Care Continues

C's father died in a train accident when she was five and her mother abandoned her. She ended up living with her Aunt and Uncle and she grew up to be a beautiful young lady.

When her Mother left she became involved in prostitution and now has given us reason to believe that she intends to use her daughter for the same purpose to bring in more money.

C's uncle does not have the power to say no or even to fight for her legally to keep her with his family. So when he heard about our vision for orphan care, he saw a way to protect her through Gloryshine.

C can be well cared for under our guidance. She will be able to receive a quality education (she entered 9th grade in June 2018) and will be brought up in the fear of the Lord. She is now under the protection of Gloryshine Orphan Care at our main church. This will cost us at least \$60 a month and we are trusting in God for His provision for her. Would you please come alongside us to help C?
