Also another happy occasion took place in our church last Sunday. A delegation of church leaders from the South Sudan Council of Churches paid a visit to us (CBC) and worshipped with us at the Munuki Parish church. They came to assess whether or not CBC is eligible to be a member of the Council.

They will meet next month to take the final decision. We have waited for 17 years to become a member of the Council.
