SEMINAR IN ADADGYA, KUMASI, GHANA

Our last seminar for the year was held in Adadgya, Kumasi in the Ashanti Region of Ghana on November 16th 2019. We had 5 Churches represented with a total attendance of 18 people. My Topic was “Added Wings: The nature of the Church in Ghana” and on the topic of Leadership, “So you think you can lead? During the discussion and the Q & A session it was apparent that some of the pastors were wrestling with the kind of gospel they were preaching. There was much discussion on what adding wings means. The question that brought us into much discussion was whether they preaching the message of the Kingdom of God or preaching their own gospel, adding things that are not biblical?

We did our best to answer the questions and to bring clarity to the truth of God’s word. We had input from some of the Senior Pastors and elders of some of the Churches, so it was encouraging to hear from other seasoned leaders. As you know, one of the compelling reasons for establishing Enrich Leadership Network is to address some of these issues and we are glad to see that in our meetings questions of such nature comes up whether we address it directly or indirectly.

Thanks for your continuous prayer and financial support that makes it possible for us to effectively carry on with the ministry of equipping. Right now, my wife and I are in St. Paul, Minnesota. She is here for her annual physical examinations. She has some appointments coming up in the next few weeks. Since I’m here, I will also see my doctor for my annual physicals. I’m hoping to return to Ghana January 7th 2020 and would love to have the opportunity to meet some of you our partners.

OUR NEEDS:

1. We need an overhead projector and a screen to be able to project our teaching during our seminars.
2. We need a 4X4 vehicle to enable us travel safely to the places we hold our seminars. Our roads in Ghana are really bad and small cars as in our case are not good for the roads. Anytime we use our small car, it comes back with more problems to be fixed. After our last trip, I will need to fix the links in the front, the shock absorbers and the front brakes. Some of the pictures will show you the road conditions we deal with. We have an offer to buy a used 4x4 Toyota Hilux at the cost \$3500.00. The offer ends in January 2020. We are looking for 35 people to give \$100.00 to get this van.
