Due to the Coronavirus outbreak and the travel ban being imposed from several continents entering into the US, I had to cut a week off of my mission trip. This created the great challenge of completing the rest of the needed meetings with future ministry possibilities, medical students, and other villages where our churches are.

God gave much wisdom and protection and helped me squeeze in as many appointments as possible before I left. I was also able to change all of my **four plane tickets** to earlier flights.

I arrived home March 19th around 7 pm and praise God that I was able to buy my domestic flight ticket for the same day soon after I landed in New York.

I was so tired after not being able to sleep around 30 plus hours, but I thank God for safe travels and I did not fall ill during this trip.

I then entered self-quarantine and appreciate your prayers for the past two weeks of my secluded time. In the first 48 hours I could not be around my children and then the next two weeks the whole family could not be around other people. This was a great time for reading some good books and being with family.

I still have to be in touch with the team overseas with phone calls and plan during this pandemic situation gets in control over our churches there and the team.

I want to take a moment to thank you for all your support and encouragement during my mission trip and even after I returned home. We Jangas are grateful for your love and prayers.

I am almost done with my self-quarantine for two full weeks and just one more day to go. It has been hard for me to not be able to hold my children during this time, especially the two little ones. The picture below is how I spent my time with them or at least for the most part.
