Dear all,

We thank you for your support and administration of the project, “House of Hope”, a community center project located in Zagreb, Croatia with the vision to serve the needs of the local community through academic tutoring and student counseling, language instruction and enculturation coaching for foreign immigrants and support for retirees and pensioners.

This letter will serve as an update to inform you of progress on the project. We have had a great season of construction and have been able to continue making progress through the pandemic.

We pleased to inform you of the following milestones since our last update:

1. Structural inspections and suggested reinforcements: **complete**
2. Framing, concrete floors and internal wall board: **complete**
3. Electrical systems and installations: **complete**
4. Plumbing systems and installations: **in progress**
5. HVAC system and installation: **in progress**
6. Landscaping and exterior improvements: **in progress**
7. Paint, decor and finish trim: **in progress**

We consider the project to be at a state of **85% completion**, with most remaining phrases being cosmetic and decorative. Within the current trajectory and budget, we anticipate the House of Hope project to be **completed in Spring of 2021** and serving guests by Summer.
