In May, we were invited to Aboaso, a town near Kumasi in the Ashanti Region, under the direction and leadership of Bishop Francis Cudjoe. We left Accra late morning on May 28th and spent the night in a hotel near the Church. We had our meeting at his Sanctuary, the Royal Seed Chapel International. We had 35 leaders excluding children and members who just wanted to learn. We had two sessions that took us to noon. After the two sessions, I had a one on one counselling session with some of the leaders at the request of the Bishop. This was the best part of the meeting, to sit with pastors and empathized with them. *There were a couple of them who felt discouraged and needed a word from God to redirect them.* Thank God for the wisdom to point them to the right direction and not to quit. *There were also some junior pastors experiencing frustrations with their Senior pastors and I have to deal with the issue of authority in the Church.*

Our plan was to return to Accra after the meeting, so after lunch at the Bishop's house, we drove another 5 hours back to Accra. Amidst rain and heavy traffic we got home safely. It was worth the call. Thanks be to the Lord.
