Dear Friends,

Greetings to you in Jesus' Name. We trust you are all well as we are here in Juba. Tabita is improving after her blood pressure went up. Thank you for your prayers. Last month, from the 18th to 21st, I lead the Ma'di 'Burulo Translating Team to visit Bishop (Rabbi) William Levi of the Beth Israel Messianic Church at his headquarters about 70 miles south of Juba on the road to Uganda. William is my nephew and lives in the States. He visits his work here from time to time. He has a number of Messianic congregations, a boarding Primary School, a Health Center and a radio station.

On our arrival we were warmly welcomed by the school choir waving Israeli and South Sudanese flags. In the morning William showed us around the compound and the new storied school block which is nearing completion. Then he took us 30 miles to the Uganda border where the radio station is based. We had a Talk Show and went on air to inform the Ma'di community about our work of translating the Bible into the Ma'di 'Burulo language. We also read a passage of the Gospel of John in Ma'di 'Burulo language and sang a hymn in the language. It was a very fruitful visit. The feedback from the listeners was very encouraging.

On the 20th we visited the farm and saw crop and fruit production. Then on the 21st we returned to Juba.
