Leadership Seminar Report

On June 25th 2020, Enrich Leadership Network in Collaboration with the Churches in Winneba in the Central Region of Ghana held a Leadership Conference. The venue was at the Supreme God Sanctuary Church, and our host Pastor was Apostle Bravery Bonney. He welcomed the participants from the various Churches and in his address, he stressed the importance of continuous learning as leaders so that they can lead their Churches well. He also thanked us for making ourselves available to serve them. I was introduced by my Coordinator Rev. Jonas Yeboah and I talked on “Keys to Church Growth” which was our Theme for the conference. I shared that;

- God’s Church can grow in grace, influence, wisdom and numerically (2 Peter 3:18)
- It’s God’s will to grow us.
- Anything that does not grow dies
- God called us to labor with Him, however, it is God who grows the Church
- Also in the presentation, I stressed firstly the role of the chief architect, The Holy Spirit (Acts 2:1-4) Secondly, the ministry of the Pastor is to concentrate on prayer and the Word, Thirdly, the

message must be about Jesus and a desire to see God move supernaturally to meet needs physically, psychologically and spiritually.

Our second speaker who is our Coordinator, Rev. Jonas Yeboah spoke on “A call for effective ministry and Church growth” He stressed on the fact that this call is a divine call and must be taken seriously. He said, Evangelism must be intentional with scripture references from (Luke 4:18) He was so passionate and shared his own testimony of how God has used him to plant two Churches in a place very difficult community in a space of two years.

We were expecting 50 people but had 54 in attendance. The Lord be praised.

Also, on August 20th 2022 in collaboration with the Good Shepherds Fellowship International we held a one- day pastors and Church leaders Conference. The venue was at the Calvary Assemblies of God Church, in Akim-Oda in the Eastern Region of Ghana.

The training commenced at 9:45am with prayers led by Pastor Daniel Adu of Global Light Church. After prayers, the Director of Programs Rev. Jonas Yeboah welcomed the participants and introduced me to speak. After leading them through the first session, the second presentation was done by my program Director who did a great job by charging them to seriously commit themselves to this heavenly call.

After the two presentation there was whole group discussion and questions and answers. After the various presentations we had a very powerful prayer session of which many dedicated their lives to God for a fresh vision and a call to discipleship. We expected 50 participants but had 21 people. We thank the Lord amidst the low attendance, there was testimony of impact which we hope would spark some revival. Some lessons learnt is to intensify our publicity. Lateness of some participants prolong the meeting.
