The gospel preached in and out of season

During Covid-19 lockdowns, a lot of our ministry to communities, churches and individuals, answering desperate calls and sending help was done by phone. As soon as restrictions were relaxed, we traveled to villages to deliver the Lord's love and compassion physically. We are grateful to The Lord for you, your invaluable support that has enabled us to meet desperate needs. Thank you Mission Aviation Fellowship for flying us to Tororo in Eastern Uganda (Lwakhakha outreach), Bukasa, Island of Lake Victoria, Arua in northwestern and Gulu in northern Uganda this year and many years.

Evangelistic outreach with Medical camps

We were joined by teams of 20-23 Christian Clinicians, Dentists, Opticians, Nurses, Dispensers, Laboratory technicians and Evangelists in outreach to Lwakhakha at the Uganda/Kenya border in February, Lwanabatya fishing village on Bukasa Island of Lake Victoria in April and Arua in northwestern Uganda in August for evangelistic outreach and medical camps. We preached the gospel, counseled and prayed with the hurting, treated the sick and gave out medicine, clothes and over 100-190

pairs of glasses in each of these place. We showed gospel videos to crowds that gathered in the evenings.

In Lwakhakha, some patients crossed from Kenya to receive this free service. We registered 302 patients and 48 praying to receive The Lord.

In Lwanabatya, many sailed by boat from surrounding islands with some from distant islands arriving the day prior to our arrival. 426 people were treated and about 50 prayed to receive The Lord.

In Arua, we received not only Ugandans but Congolese and South Sudanese. They queued up prior to our arrival and kept coming and getting served. 860 patients were treated and 128 prayed to receive The Lord as Saviour, many of them converting from Islam.

***Wajinja* idolatry: Police came to arrest us**

In September of every year, as many as 1000 - 1500 people traveled on trucks, buses and cars to Wajinja village of Lwengo district of southwestern Uganda, to worship *Wajinja* demon at the spectacular *Wajinja* Rock. Since 2015, The *Shepherds*, an interdenominational team of rural pastors and Jesus Film Ministries decided to hold annual prayer and evangelistic campaign at Kayunga Full Gospel Church in the

same village, running before and during the week of that worship.

The more we gathered, prayed and reached out to the community, the more confusion, division and fighting increased in their gatherings. This year they tried gathering as before but failed. There was no truck, bus, car or worship. The

Police Boss later informed our host that *Wajinja* priests had reported us to the Police, accusing us of hindering their gathering. We had no idea that plain-clothes police came to arrest us for blocking and hindering the worshippers. They, however, found us praying in church and carrying out evangelistic outreach. There was no 'evidence' of blockage.

Prayer items

- People will come to *Wajinja* village for the gospel and not idol worship. Please pray for Kayunga Full Gospel Church in this village. Pray for those who came to The Lord through evangelistic outreach this year and the past (yearly) outreaches. Pray for completion of the church building as it has no roof now.
- Pray for those on Islands of Lake Victoria. Increase in fuel prices has meant expensive transportation and cost of living.
- We intend to reach every Island with the gospel of God's kingdom. Many people on these Islands are unreached. Many of the little churches hardly have a church building. They face isolation because of lack of means of transportation.
- Please pray for our outreach to northern Uganda. We had started outreach in Agago district but covid-19 restrictions came in and we stopped.
- Many parts of Uganda were stricken by drought and are faced with famine. A large part of northern Uganda is affected.
- Many people especially in rural areas have no bibles as many cannot afford.
