We will be returning to Bonita Springs, Florida to help rebuild and restore the communities that were devastated by Hurricane Ian. People have experienced such great loss and some feel alone hopeless. We will share God's love and tend to those in need physically, emotionally and spirituality.

Ministry will continue in the community of IBE.(Imperial Bonita Estates) where we live. We hold Sunday evening church services, men and women's bible studies along with personal ministry one on one. Each year we hold a Service of Remembrance for all who have passed away. It is a time for the community to come together to celebrate the lives of those no longer returning.

Larry and I also serve at our city of Bonita Springs Church that is an outdoor, outreach, outstanding church that meets in the city park. They have been busy serving the community to help after Hurricane Ian. We will be working with them when we return. Plans are being made

for volunteers to be able to come and help rebuild people's lives. Construction material, clothing and household items will be sent.

Update from this summer, while in Shakopee, MN this last summer we participated in many community outreach helping meet the needs of individuals and families.

We planned with Heart a "Community Birthday Party" in Bonnevista Terrace mobile park. We had birthday cupcakes, drinks, balloons and banners sharing God's love for them. Each child received 3 presents with a blessing celebrating their lives. We shared of how they were fearfully and wonderfully made.

We have connected with our neighbors here in Shakopee and tended to their needs along the way.

Life is always an adventure. Each day is a glorious day to love God and love people. We rely on God and the Holy Spirit to be our guide and our provider.
