She was admitted to the hospital again and operated on. The doctors wanted to remove the whole breast, but we rejected the idea. So, they cut a tissue from the breast and sent it to the laboratory for a test to prove if it is indeed cancer.

At this juncture I decided to have a day to fast and pray. In the evening I went to the house of my son where the girl was and prayed for her asking the Lord to heal her. In the morning the girl and her mother returned to the hospital to hear the result of the tissue test. The result was cancer positive. So, my son decided to take his daughter to Khartoum for cancer treatment. I told him that Jesus had already killed the cancer in her body. The doctors in Khartoum would find no trace of cancer.

When they reached Khartoum, the doctors tested my granddaughter and found no cancer. But they tested the tissue removed from her in Juba and it was cancer positive, but the girl is cancer negative. My son and his daughter returned this morning from Khartoum and the girl is well. Praise the Lord!
