A Season for Some Rest and New Ministry Venture

Dear Friend,

Greetings to you from Douala, Cameroon. I pray that the strength and the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ continue to sustain you.

I was in the US in February and March of this year. It was a rather busy trip, but the Lord was faithful in supplying me with health, journey mercies, and strength. It was good to see some of you and catch up with you.

This year, I am trying to rest while finishing the consultation for Family Discipleship with four churches. I hope the Lord will revive/heal my spirit/mind/body to use me most effectively in the next chapter of ministry. I will be in the US again this summer from June to the 1st week of September, and it will be a time of mostly rest, planning, and fundraising. Before returning, I will attend the Wilberforce Institute Global Summit conference at the end of August [They are a partner ministry with CTCC].

A new chapter is starting for me in the ministry of CTCC that God has called me to do. I have prayed about this and consulted with many who have helped me hear God's voice. For the next stage of my ministry, I will partner with Treasuring Christ Networks and move to Yaoundé (Cameroon's capital city). I hope to work with the Bethlehem Baptist Church Yaoundé in this partnership to set up their Family Discipleship/Children's ministry and create a model for other churches. I will have a church family where I am encouraged and fed and work with people whose vision is like mine.

This partnership does not mean I won't continue to partner with other churches. I will still provide training, especially for the churches with whom CTCC partners. As time passes, I will share more significant insights into how this will expand on and realize the vision of God for CTCC.

Throughout the years, the Lord has been gracious to me in His guidance and provisions for ministry and in every other way. I have seen the Lord directing my steps and impressing upon my heart what He has for me and where He wants me to be. Indeed, He is steadfast in His love and faithfulness. God shows me His unfailing love through your love, prayers, and financial support for me and the ministry of CTCC. I am thankful indeed.

Please pray with me as I anticipate what God has in store.

1. Planning for Yaoundé: Pray that God will direct my every step as I prepare for Yaoundé and help me to walk the path that He has ahead of me.
2. Summer trip: God will bless my time in the US as I rest, plan, and fundraise.
3. Provision for moving to Yaoundé: Pray that God will provide a safe and secure apartment and supply all the funds required for the moving process. The estimated amount is \$5000 for moving expenses and securing an apartment for at least six months, per the practice here.
