Goats project the hope for Mr. Lalsing Budhamagar and family

Mr. Lalsing Budhamagar comes from Mid-West of Nepal. Pastor Santosh Khatiwada preached them the gospel in 2017 and they responded to the gospel. Becoming a Christian/follower of Jesus Christ was not easy for them. Because they become Christians their parents sent them out from the house in which they used to live together and the community as well. They came to Kathmandu seeking jobs and found temporary work in a brick factory. But the wages in a brick factory were so little in proportionate with the hours they had to work in a day. They had to work 15 hours per day. Sometimes they used to receive little money for hand to mouth. But most of the time – empty handed. Their master exploited them.

They have two sons; Enos and Samuel. Pastor Santosh Khatiwada visited them in brick factory and after seeing their difficult situation, he proposed them to move to Gorkha, stay at church and begin new life with goats' farm. After praying for about a month. They said "OK". Now, they are in Gorkha. They live in the church. And church with the help of Full Life Training Center wants to help them to start goats farm. And this is new hope for Mr. Lalsing Budhamagar. Will you please join in this hope?
