# A prosthesis for Consolée

Consolée Rukundo was a toddler when her parents and siblings, uncles, aunts, grandparents, were murdered during the Shangi genocide and her arm was cut off. "Incredible to see this young woman lovingly visit old widows or visit with me at the Memorial where all her relatives were murdered. The story is moving - her warmth even more so. During all our visits she showed how much love she has for the victims of the genocide, although she herself has experienced so much suffering." (Matthias Schaffrath). Consolée was Teakwondo Africa and World Champion. She passes on her courage and passion to Iriba Shalom Rwanda and its members.

Consolée has a heart for those affected but needs help herself in the form of a prosthesis. Through an electric prosthesis, she would like not only to be able to shape her own everyday life, but also to help widows and young people and give them courage with her story. For the myo-electric prosthesis, instead of the 45,000€ it would cost in Germany, only a total of about 20,000 € is needed by manufacturing it in Kenya (including about 4,000 € travel and accommodation costs for the 4-week fitting in Nairobi). # Health insurance
