Greetings from Ladkrabang, Bangkok, Thailand.

I would like to share a story of one of our students who accepted the Lord Jesus last January through our Level 4 class interview.

"How do you feel when you accepted Jesus as your personal Savior and Lord?" Bow answered, "I felt, hope and I am happy."

Bow decided to join our worship and cell group the following Sunday. When she was about to park her car near Santisuk center, her parents called because her grandfather was rushed to the emergency room. She rushed to the hospital to be with her grandfather but that afternoon her grandfather died. Bow was not able to be in her English class the following week because she was busy with the wake and her grandmother was hospitalized and died that week too. After two weeks of being busy and tired. She decided to attend school even if she was 2 weeks late. She joined our Sunday Worship and we prayed for her and encouraged her. Teacher Carol and Teacher Deb taught her how to pray and encouraged her to read her New Testament Thai and English Bible.

Bow studied with us last 2022 and came back last November 2023. Bow understood the stories of Jesus taught in our English classes. She also understood the Gospel when Pastor Dondon shared it to her during the level four students' interview.
