In March, a group of 20 people from Jacksonville, TX, El Paso, TX, and Ciudad Juárez, México, loaded up into vans and drove 15 hours south to the town of Baborigame. We spent our spring break week taking part in Vacation Bible School and outreach services for the community. We are so grateful for the many who supported this trip in a variety of ways to make it a success: from bicycles and clothing donations to the monetary donations that helped us make sure our vehicles were ready for the trip through the mountains. On our final day of ministry, 700 kids gathered for “El Gran Día” (The Big Day). During the celebration, the kids sang, played, broke piñatas, and heard about the love of Jesus. Also, over 200 adults received a bag of groceries to take home.
