LIVES Saved by HIS Amazing Grace & Transformed for HIS Glory

God has given me countless job opportunities since I graduated college in October 1998. One of my experiences, was working as a grade school principal in one of the universities in Dumaguete City, Philippines. It is where I met Christy Yumul along with many other students who applied for work scholarship. I had eight working students and ten professional licensed teachers under my care and supervision in my department. In September 2010, I suggested to our local church pastor that we conduct a weekly Bible study in my department concealed as "team building" anxious that the university's top admin would fire me had they known we were preaching the gospel in a blatantly atheistic environment. My proposed "team building" schedules were approved by the university president. However, late 2011 God exposed the real conditions of the hearts of the attendees that three of the teachers heavily involved in cults accused me of proselytizing them. Due to lack of proof, I wasn't dismissed but I opted to resign in April 2012 because deep in my heart affirmed by the Scripture I was sure my savior is calling me to another phase of my journey with Him. Christy lived with my family for two more years after I resigned being nurtured in His Words and going to church fellowships at least three times a week.

In 2018, a year after God brought me to be a part of Santisuk Ministries through BSOP, Christy called and told me the great news -- an answer to my prayers -- that she had a meeting with her family telling them she is a believer and follower of Jesus Christ. She made it clear with them that she's no longer going to the Roman Catholic church with them nor be a part with all the traditions the RCs are doing. We may be apart for thousands of miles but thank God for the availability of technology, I am able to continuously teach, admonish, encourage and pray with and for her. Praise God for the unexpected blessing of reuniting us even for a short time here in Bangkok on July 5 - 16. She is now actively involved in the various ministries of His Life Ministries, Dumaguete City, Philippines. Please pray for her that God will use her mightily in His kingdom, and that God will provide all her needs.
