Sustainability at Children's Ministries Agape Farm

Deep in the bush of Zambia, Africa, is the well-grounded project of Children's Ministries Agape Farm (CMAF) providing Christian education (Grade 1-7), school lunches for 550+ students, gardening, chapel, wells for water, vocational and spiritual training with the long-term focus of sustainability. CMAF is 3.5 - 5 hours of travel time to larger cities. Its ministries happen in the midst of no electricity, no potable water, crocodiles, poisonous snakes and God's enabling and love.

Each day begins with Bible study for staff and teachers. Chapel for the students includes songs, teaching and prayer. Memorizing the Ten Commandments has been the focus for this school year. Parents have positive comments regarding the students' memorization. New vibrancy is emerging as we take greater strides in development at CMAF.

- 1) **\$7,200** – Grow Sustainable School Lunches
 - \$1,200 For additional seeds, fertilizer and varieties for nutritionally balanced lunches.
 - \$6,000 (\$500/month) To purchase food to match food quantities lost in crop failure from drought.



- 2) **\$2,000** - Water. Two additional wells (drilled and tapped) will provide irrigation for increased planting and prevent crop failure experienced in 2024. \$2,000 will provide water purification for human consumption.



3) **\$1,200** - Internet Access. Starlink (purchased and installed) will provide internet access for CMAF. However, we have found out we need an extra boost of energy supply for consistent access.

- \$700 for equipment
- \$ 40/month (service fee for effective communication with the outside world)

4) **\$1,000** - Natural Biogas Fuel and Fertilizer Generator.
Installation and generation of biogas would produce cooking fuel for the school and fertilizer for the gardening.



5) **\$1,800** - Bricks. CMAF is blessed to make our own bricks for buildings. \$1,800 buys termite prevention and cement for laying up to 15,000 bricks.

6) **\$4,000** - Staff House construction, complete with windows, doors, plumbing, appliances, etc. Zambian Government will provide teachers, CMAF to provide houses. Four additional houses could be used now.



God's love continues to reach out through the Jesus Film and Prison Ministry.

Our goal is to prioritize sustainable solutions. With God's help we can meet these goals for the children of CMAF.
