Isaias' Story:



Isaias is a psychologist and director of **Fundación Niños de Paz**, a **nonprofit organization partnered with Mentor a Mentor** in Floridablanca, Colombia. From a young age, Isaias felt called to serve vulnerable communities. His psychology degree and YWAM training in Cartagena prepared him to found Fundación Niños de Paz.

Together with his wife Patricia, Isaias provides services for at-risk neighborhoods, including psychology and social work support, after-school tutoring, senior citizen activities, and a Saturday morning Bible club for children and teens.

For years, Isaias and Patricia prayed for a robotics program for youth in Barrio La Paz, recognizing its potential to shape their futures. When Isaias met Cara, the director of Mentor a Mentor, at church, they discussed the possibility of a mentorship program for his foundation. Thanks to their collaboration, the robotics program has served 17 vulnerable students for over a year, equipping them with essential skills.

This **Giving Tuesday**, we aim to raise **\$5,000**, with **\$1,160** going toward purchasing two laptops for this vital program. Thank you for considering a donation!
