# A MILESTONE: OPENING OF THE SENIORS' HOME IN MUKOMA

A highlight of my trip was the official opening of the seniors' home by ISHAR in Mukoma, accompanied by our chairwoman Denise Uwimana-Reinhardt and myself. On Dec. 4, 2024, 14 out of 16 elderly women moved into their new home, where they now receive care, security, and comfort - things that were out of reach for many of them for a long time. Representatives of the Rwandan government and media were also present, emphasizing the significance of this project. Alongside the joy and warmth of the residents, a special highlight was a gift from our association: a cow, which will provide fresh milk in the future. The delight of the elderly women was immense an unforgettable moment!

# IT-PROJECT IN RWAMAGANA

During my trip, me and some other members of IRISI, had the opportunity to visit the ongoing computer course in Rwamagana, a project by SHAM, which was launched in fall 2024 with partial support from *Cents for Help e.V.* Here, 20 young adults are being trained in IT skills that aim to open doors to a better future.

During our visit, we were impressed by the enthusiasm of the students and the skills they had already acquired. They proudly demonstrated what they had learned and shared their hopes and goals. The gratitude and determination to make the most of this opportunity were palpable – a moving moment that underscored how education can truly change lives.









### THE WEDDING OF CHARLES VITAL RUKONDO

Another highlight of the trip, and a deeply personal event, was the wedding of Denise Uwimana-Reinhardt's eldest son, Charles Vital Rukondo. As a member of IRISI and a genocide survivor, his wedding was a symbol of resilience, joy, and the strength of community across generations in Rwanda. The celebrations were attended by family and friends from around the world, as well as members and staff from our partner organizations.







# MICROFINANCING AND SMALL PROJECTS

Several visits took me to small-scale projects by members of our partners. These individuals receive financial startup support of approximately €100 to €500 after developing a business plan, enabling them to start small businesses. These initiatives range from selling fruits and vegetables to trading goods and raising animals.

It was fascinating to speak with the participants, hear their stories, and witness the remarkable successes, particularly in animal husbandry. Such initiatives not only foster independence but also provide a stable and sustainable income, offering families a solid foundation for the future.
