That was until Sarah received a dairy goat from our project. The goat, named "Hope," has been a game-changer for Sarah and her family. With the milk and cheese

produced by Hope, Sarah is now able to earn a steady income, selling excess produce at the local market.

"The goat has been a blessing," Sarah says with a smile. "I can now afford to send my children to school, and we have enough food to eat. I feel empowered and hopeful for the future."

Since receiving the goat, Sarah's income has increased enabling her to improve her living conditions and provide for her family's basic needs. She has also become a role model in her community, inspiring other widows to take control of their lives.

That was until Bukuwa's received a solar system from our project. The solar panels and battery have transformed her life, providing reliable and clean energy for her family. "The solar system has been a game-changer," Bukuwa's says with a smile. "We can now study and work at night, and I can even charge my phone to stay connected with my community."
