As we approach Giving Tuesday, on December 3rd, a global day dedicated to generosity and making a difference, I hope that you will consider lifting up a widow in the Kimwanga Widows Project. Your kindness and compassion mean so much to the widows, and we deeply appreciate your support.

About the Kimwanga Widows Project

The **Kimwanga Widows Project** is a ministry that brings care and sustainable support to widows in rural Uganda. Through several initiatives, we aim to improve their quality of life. Here are the main ways we're making a difference:

- **Goat Project**

Through this program, we provide a dairy goat to each widow, empowering her to improve her nutrition and create a sustainable income. The goat produces milk that can be consumed and sold, offspring can be sold, and further offspring can be passed on to another widow. Thus, one widow is helping another.

- **Bedding Initiative**

Many of our widows currently sleep on the floor with little to keep them warm at night. We provide them with a mattress, blanket, bedsheets, and a wood bed frame to ensure they have a comfortable place to rest their aging bodies.

- **Additional Support:**

We make home visits to each of the widows to ensure medical conditions are being addressed, offer encouragement, and pray with each of them to share the gospel. Our assistance programs include housing. Termites and rain severely damage housing in our regions, and we often see widows with homes needing repairs for structural safety.



Our Goal for Giving Tuesday:

We aim to raise **\$3,800 by December 7th, the week of Giving Tuesday**, to support 20 widows and their families. This includes providing bedding for 10 families and establishing goat micro businesses for another 10 families. This Giving Tuesday, we hope to build a community of 20 donors who will stand with us in this mission.
