As a family, it was not a simple task to make decisions for my mom, but we're thankful for God's guidance.

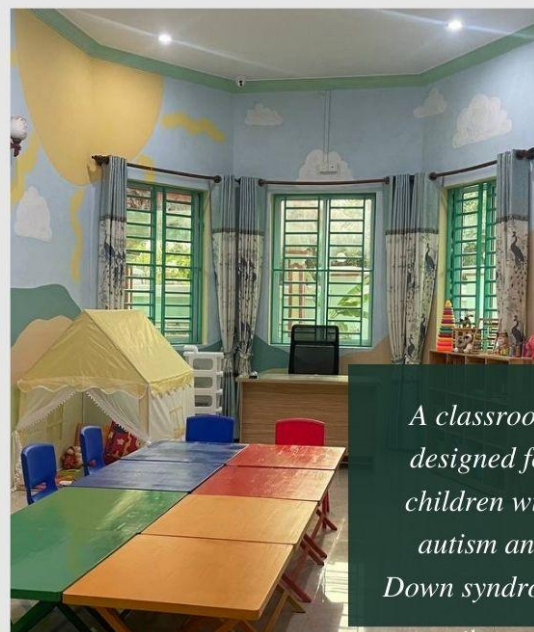
Despite everything, God has always been gracious and kind towards us.

PRAYER REQUESTS

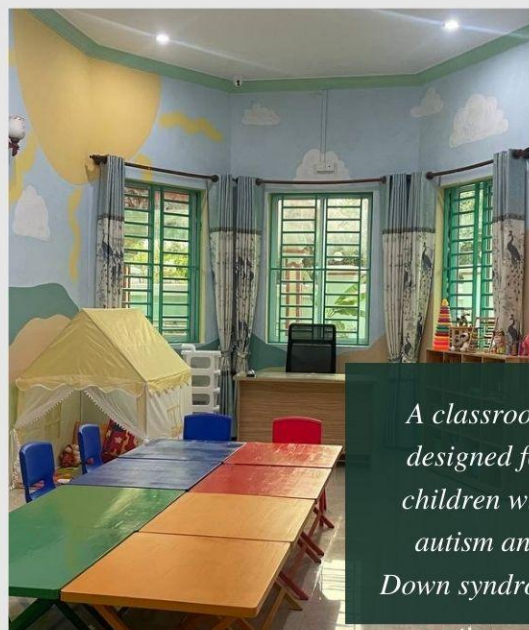


1. Pray for my mother's recovery and for God to sustain her with strength while she is in pain due to the tubes in her body.
