**We Run, We Rise: A New Milestone in Meaningful Youth
Engagement**



From January to March, we have been engaging stakeholders for our new project, **We Run, We Rise, under our Meaningful Youth Engagement Program**, generously supported by the **Micah 6:8 Foundation**. After acceptance from the **Siaya County Ministry of Education**, our **Bishop of Bondo Diocese**, and **Maseno West Diocese**, we embarked on parent sensitization sessions for both parents and the general community in the 16 public schools within Bondo, Rarieda and Ugunja Regions, Siaya County in Kenya where this project will be implemented.

This year, the program aims to directly reach **800 learners aged 9–15 years**, and indirectly benefit the entire school population, approximately **9200 in the participating schools**, creating ripple effects throughout the broader school communities.

In April 14th to 18th, we will conduct training for coaches from the selected schools and churches, preparing them as facilitators for the program. The official implementation of We Run, We Rise Curriculum will then begin in May.



This new project aims to promote the **holistic well-being** of children and adolescents by integrating **physical activities** with **environmental, social, mental, and spiritual education**. We look forward to witnessing the positive impact this initiative will have on children and adolescents.

International Women's Day 2025: Accelerating Action for Gender Equality








On **March 8th**, we joined the world in celebrating **International Women's Day (IWD)**—a global occasion to honor the social, economic, cultural, and political achievements of women. This year's theme, "**Accelerate Action**," was a rallying call for progress toward gender parity and the elimination of all forms of **gender-based violence (GBV)**.

In solidarity with women and girls, we held a special event at **Vitech Training Institute in Bondo Sub-County, Siaya**, where we engaged in powerful conversations on women's empowerment and GBV prevention. We were privileged to **partner with the Bondo Sub-County Health Management Team**, enabling participants to access **Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights (SRHR) services**.



A total of **31 participants** received SRHR services, including **cervical cancer screening**. In addition, **IFAGE** distributed **sanitary towels** to all female participants, ensuring menstrual dignity for women and girls in attendance.
