Creating Safe Spaces for Children to Thrive...

This April, we trained 32 coaches from 16 public schools and churches to launch the Youth Running Club project—a new initiative where physical activity is paired with mental, social, spiritual, and environmental health for well-being and holistic development of children and youth.

Why Youth Running Clubs...

With the changing world of technology, climate and parenting styles, children and adolescents face pressure from many sides—stress, peer pressure, and harmful cultural norms. These clubs help them build resilience, confidence, and purpose—not just through movement, but through meaningful conversations and guidance.





More than just sports, these clubs are safe spaces for children aged 9–15 to grow, build confidence, and shape stronger, healthier communities.

We are proud to be working closely with 16 government public schools in this effort for this year and hope to expand our reach within Siaya County, Kenya, and even beyond.

Faith & SRHR: Safe Spaces Now Connected to Health Facilities for SRHR Services.

Religious leaders in our **SRHR Interfaith Coalition** have been turning churches into safe spaces—places where youth can speak openly about SRHR without fear or stigma.

Now, these faith-based safe spaces have taken a major step forward: They're **officially linked to 8 youth-friendly health facilities** across Siaya County.





Together with the **County and Sub-County Health Management Teams**, we've rolled out the **MoH 100 referral tool** to track and improve access to care. A follow-up meeting brought together youth, faith leaders, and health reps to strengthen this collaboration.

One Goal: Meaningful Youth Engagement

Both projects are part of our Meaningful Youth Engagement program—our commitment to ensuring that no young person is left behind in accessing the information, care, and support they need to thrive.
