With a community that is filled with a lot of unthinkable or unimaginable hardship, God has blessed the Youngsters for Christ mission to be a voice of reason amidst so much confusion in the lives of young girls who go through a lot of shame, embarrassment, and even stigma due to their monthly cycle. Our "dignify a girl" outreach program has been going its way to even rescue the girl child who has been going through molestation, as it is due to a lack of sanitary towels. Keeping them in homes in the villages to stay with different families to keep them safe. Many go through such due to a lack of sanitary towels because of this challenge, many have become prey, to the point where some have been found with STIs. With this challenge, we have been able to help a few of these girls monthly.

Kibera is a place that is overcrowded by the population and families living below the poverty line. With the hardship that people go through, it's heartbreaking when you end up losing everything you have owed in such an environment. It is hard to imagine that some families, especially widows and children, lose all that they knew, their beddings, clothing, shelter, because of a fire that engulfed all that they had, with few escaping with injuries. As a mission, we are trying to help for the time being, as some of them are camping in our mission building, and we are trusting God to come through for them.
