### To our dear friends who have prayed, and supported the work in Gorkha,

Thank you for your constant mentorship and praying for us to grow in the Lord. We are grateful for your friendship and guidance. I would like to share what the Lord is doing here in Nepal and invite you to consider praying for us. Monsoon has started in Nepal. Highways are under construction therefore potential landslides and road accidents have created fear. Yet, we trust God is in control. He is LORD of all creation. As Psalmist sings, “The Earth and everything in it belongs to Jehovah for he founded it upon the seas and established it upon the floods.” – Psalms 24.1-2.



In Nepal, 78.3 percent of the total population can read and write according to the survey done by the government of Nepal in 2022. This also includes the church and its leadership. Most of our senior leaders are excellent in speaking, storytelling and in verbal communication. Praise God for this special ability and the gift. On the other hand, further training in scripture is needed for pastors and church leaders to understand it, interpret it and apply it for daily living. I was blessed to have completed formal theological training at the seminary and it's my desire to share this knowledge to equip local churches.



In view of this, Full Life Training Center organized a one-day preaching workshop in the city of Gorkha. 27 pastors and leaders attended this workshop. The participants left the workshop with new skills to apply to their services. Following the workshop, Pastor Chandra bahadur Tamang shared, “Initially I was little hesitant to attend this workshop because there are a lot of trainings happening, but I came and now I understand the value of this training.” Pastor Simon Shrestha shared, “I am serving as a pastor for 15 years, and this is my first training in preaching, and it has helped me to prepare a Christ-centered sermon.” Your generous gifts made this possible. We are planning for another half day mini preaching workshop for

the same group in July. Please join us in prayer for wisdom as I prepare teaching materials and for the church leaders who will attend.



Everyday 1,700 youth leave Nepal for overseas work. Some return and some do not. The narration in Nepal is “nothing happens in Nepal”. There are no factories, no work opportunities, therefore, youth are seeking new ways to invest themselves. FLTC's vision is to create work opportunities to keep young adults in the country, caring for their families and building strong communities. I want to introduce you Keshar Khatiwada. At one time he left his family in Nepal but has returned to the village where he belongs, to help strengthen our community. He has a strong faith and hope in Christ. Keshar leads praise songs and house fellowship at Grace Church

and he is very excited about FLTC's work. He has started teaching at a private school, but his passion is to help other local families who are struggling. Keshar plans to start an organic chili pepper farm in the village, to create work for a family to remain in Nepal. Please pray for Keshar as he leads this project and for the family who will be up lifted.
