In general, as a country, we have been going through a season of turmoil due to politics, where bloodshed and deaths have occurred. Although in the midst of such, we have carefully continued to attend to the work of the mission in different communities and villages.



Almost three weeks ago, we were able to bring a group of women where we gathered in one of the village's small building, where I spoke to them about the issues and matters arising that have continued to affect the society and community. The reason we chose to speak with the women is that we believe they have a voice in the family and community. We thank God the meeting went so well, and amid our talk, 8 ladies requested I pray with them to give their lives to Christ. I was glad this happened, and I thank God.

Being a missionary in your community is not an easy thing, but it takes the grace of God and having a purpose-driven heart and mind to make Christ known together with the mission team, Youngsters for Christ. Just to mention, the issues of the girl child is something so important that needs to be given a lot of consideration, especially during their time of the month. Our mission has continued to step in to reach out to these girls without minding their religion, as we support these girls monthly as we continue to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ with them. The Youngsters for Christ team, on a monthly basis, has a

target of at least 600 girls who are in dire need; however, due to the challenges and hardship, we are only able to reach below 100 with sanitary towels. **You can lend a hand of support to these girls; keep a girl clean, maintain menstrual hygiene.**



When visiting communities and villages, sometimes it is so overwhelming when you see children playing with each other, but when you notice you are coming, a group of children will come around you and ask you for something to eat because a majority of these children can go a day or two without a meal. Two weeks ago, you visited a community where these children meet under a tree to be taught. However, it was so heartbreaking that the much our mission team had brought ended before others were able to be served. Please pray for us as we continue to share hope. Perhaps if we continue to join hands more, we will be able to make a difference through your kind gift.





As a mission, we sincerely appreciate our partnership and your monthly gift. we try so much to stretch it to do the work of the mission. God bless you so much and continue to provide as we continue to trust him for more open doors.
