Looking Ahead and Pressing Needs Ahead

- **Temporary Class Shelter** – To protect our learners from heavy rains and scorching sun, we urgently need \$850.
- **School Uniforms for Orphans** – Our goal is to raise \$600 through DonorSee to provide uniforms for our children.
- **School Development** – We dream of acquiring land, building permanent classrooms, and launching school farming projects for long-term sustainability.
