Bibles – Please support us to purchase and give out more vernacular bibles.

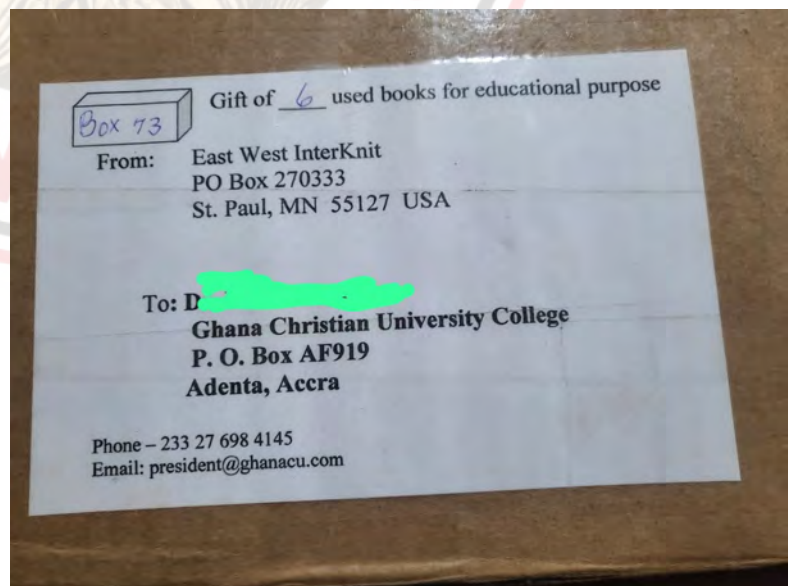
