## BABY GRANT'S JOURNEY: A STORY OF HOPE

This year, we witnessed one of the most touching miracles in our ministry **the transformation of Baby Grant.**



Thanks to your kindness:

- His **first cleft lip surgery** was successfully completed.
- At **nine months**, he will undergo the second operation to repair the palate.
- Though he still feeds by bottle, his **nutrition and growth have greatly improved.**
- His mother and family now smile with hope, after months of fear and uncertainty.

But the journey is not finished.

We prayerfully seek **\$2,600** to complete his surgery and aftercare in **May 2026.**

## 2. MT. OLIVET CARE VIEW SCHOOL – 2025 YEAR IN REVIEW

In 2025, the school served **170 pupils** with a dedicated team of **15 staff** who faithfully nurtured, taught, and cared for our children many of whom are **orphans and vulnerable learners.**



### Key Achievements

- **Top-Class Graduation:** Transition to Primary One celebrated with joy.
- **Strong Feeding Program:** Ensured daily meals, boosting attendance and performance.

- **Co-curricular Success:** Games, music, and creative arts strengthened confidence.
- **Parent Engagement:** Regular meetings and trainings improved school–community relations.
- **Good Governance:** Active board and staff meetings strengthened accountability.



## 2026 Priorities

1. **Increasing enrollment and expanding classroom space**
2. **Completing key structures:**
  - Boys' dormitory | *\$1,500 needed*
  - Kitchen structure | *\$1,000 needed*
  - Putting flow/covering all classrooms | *\$1,800 needed*
3. **Compound improvements**
  - Lights installation
  - Secure school fencing
4. **Staff welfare**
  - Monthly salaries support | *\$400/month*
5. **Feeding program sustainability**
  - Support needed | *\$400/month*
6. **School supplies:** Teachers & pupil requirements | *\$250/month*

## Long-term Need – Land for Expansion

- **2 acres needed: Cost: \$10,000**

Your partnership continues to shape the lives of children who would otherwise have no access to quality education or daily meals. Thank you for giving them hope.



## HEALTH DEPARTMENT – BALAWOLI MEDICAL CLINIC

The clinic continued providing essential care amid **high patient loads**, especially from **malaria**, typhoid, and MCH services.



### 2025 Highlights

- **New Health Unit:** Structure nearing completion (needs doors & windows).
- **Health Camp:** Screened patients for malaria, HIV, typhoid, PUD & dewormed children.
- **Community Engagement:** WASH trainings, hygiene promotion, spiritual counseling.
- **Drug Supply:** Medicines like paracetamol and ACTs ran out within a week due to high demand.

### 2026 Critical Needs

- **Land for expansion** – 1 acre @ \$5,000
- **Reliable medicine supply** – \$180/month
- **Staff support** – \$150/month

Final completion of clinic building – \$1,100

The health team has shown remarkable courage despite challenges. Your support keeps this clinic running—and saving lives.

## 4. BALAWOLI VOCATIONAL INSTITUTE – EMPOWERING YOUTH

For six years, the institute has served **teen mothers, orphans, unemployed youths, and vulnerable families** with practical vocational skills.



### Courses offered

- Tailoring & Cutting
- Welding & Fabrication
- Hairdressing & Beauty
- Life skills & employment

## Achievement in 2025

- Strengthened instructor training
- Provided tools and materials
- Continued construction of lecture rooms & offices
- Supported vulnerable students with practical skills for income generation

## 2026 Needs

- Instructional materials
  - Staff: *\$150/term*
  - Students: *\$150/term*
- Staff support – *\$200/month*
- Land acquisition – *1 acre @ \$5,000*
- Completion of permanent structures

## 5. BIG VISION FOR 2026 – THE LAND PROJECT (\$20,000)

Land is the foundation for sustainability: In 2026, C4DMU's biggest goal is securing **4 acres** for long-term growth:

- **Primary School – 2 acres (\$10,000)**
- **Medical Center – 1 acre (\$5,000)**
- **Vocational Institute – 1 acre (\$5,000)**

- Food production for feeding programs
- Stable & permanent central facilities
- Ability to expand classrooms, clinics & training spaces
- Security and independence
- Long-term sustainability for future generations
