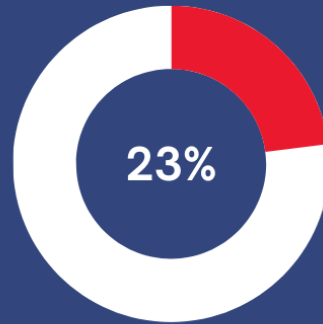

## A Story of Impact: Daniela

Our mentorship programs have transformed Daniela's path and reflect what is possible for vulnerable girls across Latin America. In the region, more than 51 million adolescent girls face structural risks such as limited access to technology, education, and opportunities, and nearly half of all children under 18 live in monetary poverty. Research consistently shows that when girls in vulnerable situations receive support before age 12, they are far more likely to avoid early pregnancy, substance use, and other high-risk situations.

When Daniela joined our program two years ago, she had never used a computer. Today, at just 13, she is one of the leaders in our robotics club—programming, helping younger students, building robots, and competing in tournaments.
