- With the overwhelming population in Kibera, there is a group of people who have been neglected and left behind, widows. Most of them are grandmothers who have been left to care for their grandchildren. Many of the children are orphans. As a mission, we have been visiting them and praying with them, and when God provides, we ensure we reach out to them by going to different communities and villages. We feel strongly that God loves these people and He has a good plan for them.



- Graciously, our children's program has continued to be made accessible to them by our well-able team using relevant ways to share the Gospel, which are: skits, coloring, memory verses, poems, etc. This has made the same children become effective messengers to their fellow children in the communities and villages. One of the things that makes this program attractive to them is the feeding part of the program. The majority go without food for 2 days. We thank God for enabling the Gospel to reach this generation, together with you.



- Our society has been, and villages have been, so inhumane to our girl child. Because of the hardship and the challenges, some girls have been sexually abused and have had their dignity taken away. Through the mission, we have been able to reach these girls, have counsel with them, and also share Christ with them. When God provides, we can be a blessing to them monthly as we dignify them. This month of December, we would like to welcome you as we plan to reach out to more than 600-700, this being the month of sharing. We would like to ask for a special gift donation towards the girls, where we would like to donate a pair of undergarments and hygiene towels. We hope to raise \$1850.
