We are overjoyed to report back on our Thanksgiving mission trip to the remote mountain town of Baborigame. A group of 16 adults and teenagers drove 16 hours south to spend the week conducting Vacation Bible School and outreach services for families. Thanks to the generous help of many of our supporters, we were also able to bring Christmas gifts to around 700 children, groceries to 200 families, and a large amount of clothing for those that need it. Bicycles, piñatas, candy, and toys aside, the most rewarding part of these trips is always the time we are able to spend with the families with whom we have developed beautiful friendships over the years. One highlight was welcoming a music group from the church in town to play at an outdoor evening service. An indigenous woman sang "I Have Decided to Follow Jesus" in her native language (Tepehuán), and it was a beautiful moment of understanding the breadth and depth of God's love in this world.
