An Update from Casa Hogar Adonai

Greetings to everyone from **Chihuahua, Mexico**,

Javier and I (Rebecca) are currently in Chihuahua, Mexico, where we had the opportunity to visit a very special place for us, **Casa Hogar Adonai**, an orphanage that Mentor a Mentor has partnered with since 2016. (Rebecca was present at the groundbreaking of Casa Hogar Adonai in 2008). Through this

partnership, Mentor a Mentor supports weekly Capoeira classes, which are held twice a week for the children at the orphanage.

Casa Hogar Adonai is led by **Luis and Cecilia**, a couple deeply rooted in their love for Jesus Christ, who have dedicated their lives to caring for these children. At this time, they are providing a home for 38 children. During our time with them, we heard stories marked by hardship, but also by deep joy, resilience, and hope.

Cecilia shared one story that highlights the impact of Capoeira. **“Ana”** (name changed for privacy), a young girl at the orphanage, suffered a serious accident that resulted in a spinal injury. Doctors gave her a very low chance of walking again. After a difficult hospital stay, Cecilia fought to bring her back to the orphanage, where she could receive consistent care and love.

Today, Ana is able to care for herself in many ways and is receiving physical therapy. They have begun to see encouraging signs of improvement. Cecilia believes that Ana’s Capoeira training helped build the upper body strength she now relies on to live more independently in her wheelchair.

Luis and Cecilia asked us to express their **deep gratitude** to all of you for your prayers and financial support. Having Gabriel, a young adult who comes weekly to lead exercise and give Capoeira classes, is incredibly meaningful to the children and a vital support to their ministry.

Luis and Cecilia shared the following prayer requests:

- Please pray for God's protection and favor over the orphanage, as they have faced many challenges this year and have felt spiritually attacked.
- Please pray for the children in their schooling. Many are struggling academically, and some are still learning to read and write.

In addition, Luis and Cecilia shared a **practical need** at the orphanage. Having an additional **sports instructor and academic tutor** during the week would greatly support the children by providing consistent guidance, encouragement, and structure. **Mentor a Mentor would love to help meet this need** by supporting the addition of at least one more mentor to serve the children at Casa Hogar Adonai.
