ACHIEVEMENTS

1. Having daily reading schedules:

- **Around 30 – 40 children come to the library for guided reading from Monday to Saturday morning.**

2. Conducting after school classes.

- **These are classes mainly for upper primary children (P.5, P.6 and P.7), Children are taught real MATH skills to improve on their Mathematics.**

3. Digital Literacy:

- **This is a program comprising of both primary and secondary students who are being trained to attain computer use skills and internet for research.**

4. Chess training:

- **These classes are changing the mind set of our children by attaining critical thinking through the chess game.**
- **Our children also had a chance to watch the (QUEEN OF KATWE) a chess game movie on boxing day last year.**

5. Nurturing children to fear God throughout the community:

- **This is done through the devotion schedules children are taken through at the library every Saturday.**

6. Financial literacy classes:

- **These are classes which are going on at the library twice a week and at the moment, we are engaging Module 7 and this is greatly improving saving culture, business creation, business sustainability etc to community people.**

7. Sports and games:

- **We train children the ball games and this is empowering the children how to socialise with one another hence creating friendly discipline.**

CHALLENGES.

- 1. The biggest challenge faced is when we have no income at hand, we lack electricity at times.**
- 2. One former volunteer worker went away with our library laptop and damaged it.**

ON GOING ACTIVITY.

- **We are in coordination with St. Paul Waitambogwe Church of Uganda doing evangelism through showing religious movies on projectors to the community people.**
