

# Joy Children's Centre Term 1 Update!

We are pleased to present the report on changes implemented at Joy Children's Centre (JCC) at the beginning of Term 1, 2026. Your generous support has enabled us to make significant improvement in the society, academic and learning processes in the school.



**New Year - New Changes**

1. **Increase in Learner enrollment;** The number of children rose from 107 students to 136, expanding the student body and creating more opportunities for education to our community children.
2. **Teacher and support staff recruitment;** Three new teachers were hired to strengthen the learning process and address shortages in specific subjects and strengthen the sanitation and security of our premises, despite this addition, there remains a need for further staffing in some areas.
3. **Teacher Promotion;** Selected teachers were promoted to Deputy and Director of studies easing administrative work and enhancing academic oversight.
4. **Infrastructure development;** New classes ( P1,P2,P3 and P4) were portioned out the tent with a cemented floor, solving the problem of inadequate classroom space.
5. **Candidate Class;** A candidate class has been established for the first time, positioning the school to gain recognition locally and beyond.
6. **Curriculum materials;** New textbooks aligned with the curriculum were purchased, contributing to improved academic performance.
7. **Weekly assessments;** The school is able to assess learners on a weekly basis to monitor learner's progress effectively, personalized support for struggling students and the data is used to adjust teaching methods resulting in improved learner outcomes.
8. Introduction of remedial lessons more in the afternoon to improve on the learner's reading and Handwriting practices to attain uniform handwriting at school.
9. Implementation of teaching methods learnt from the (TFS) workshop last year by the teachers.
10. More chairs have been added to the school for the staff and the children.

These changes were made at the start of Term one 2026 to enhance the overall environment and performance of JCC, fostering better learning outcomes for the children.

We sincerely appreciate your continued support and partnership in making these positive changes at Joy's Children's Centre. Your generosity has directly impacted lives our students, staff and the community at large enhancing their learning environment and opportunities.
